

Privacy Policy:

At the Victoria County Senior Citizens Association, we recognize that privacy is important. This Policy applies to all information collected by the Victoria County Senior Citizens Association.

Information we collect and how we use it:

We offer a number of services that do not require you to register for an account or provide any personal information to us. In order to provide our full range of services, we may collect the following types of information:

- **Information you provide** - When you submit inquiries, we ask you for personal information (such as your name, email address and phone number). In order to provide you with the information and to improve the quality of our services.
- **User communications** - When you send email or other communication to the Victoria County Senior Citizens Association, we may retain those communications in order to process your inquiries, respond to your requests and improve our services. The Victoria County Senior Citizens Center processes personal information on our servers in the United States of America.

Information sharing

The Victoria County Senior Citizens Association does not share any information to outside companies or individuals. If the Victoria County Senior Citizens Association becomes involved in a merger, acquisition, or any form of sale of some or all of its assets, we will provide notice before personal information is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

Information security

We take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or unauthorized alteration, disclosure or destruction of data. These include internal reviews of our data collection, storage and processing practices and security measures, as well as physical security measures to guard against unauthorized access to systems where we store personal data.

We restrict access to personal information to Victoria County Senior Citizens Association employees, contractors and agents who need to know that information in order to operate, develop or improve our services. These individuals are bound by confidentiality obligations and may be subject to discipline, including termination and criminal prosecution, if they fail to meet these obligations.

Data integrity

The Victoria County Senior Citizens Association processes personal information only for the purposes for which it was collected and in accordance with this Policy or any applicable service-specific privacy notice. We review our data collection, storage and processing practices to ensure that we only collect, store and process the personal information needed to provide or improve our services. We take reasonable steps to ensure that the personal information we process is accurate, complete, and current, but we depend on our users to update or correct their personal information whenever necessary.
